

Peeter Ross – An European expert on eHealth

With Peeter Ross (Estonia, Tallinn University of Technology) a well-known international expert on eHealth joins the second eHealth Innovation days 2017 in Flensburg. He is professor at Tallinn University of Technology, eMedicine Laboratory, an expert at the Estonian eHealth Foundation and a radiologist at the East Tallinn Central Hospital. Furthermore, he participated in EU funded eHealth projects InterregPacs, Baltic eHealth, R-Bay, Dreaming, Regional Telemedicine Forum, epSOS, eMedic and Chromed.

The research topics of Peeter Ross comprise **medical terminology, integration of home monitoring data with large scale health databases, and citizen on-line access to personal health related data.**

In July 2017 **Estonia took over the rotating Presidency of the European Council.** Digitalization and technological progress are the main topics until the end of this year.

Peeter Ross will give us an update about eHealth in Estonia as well the current key aspects and challenges about eHealth on the European stage.
